



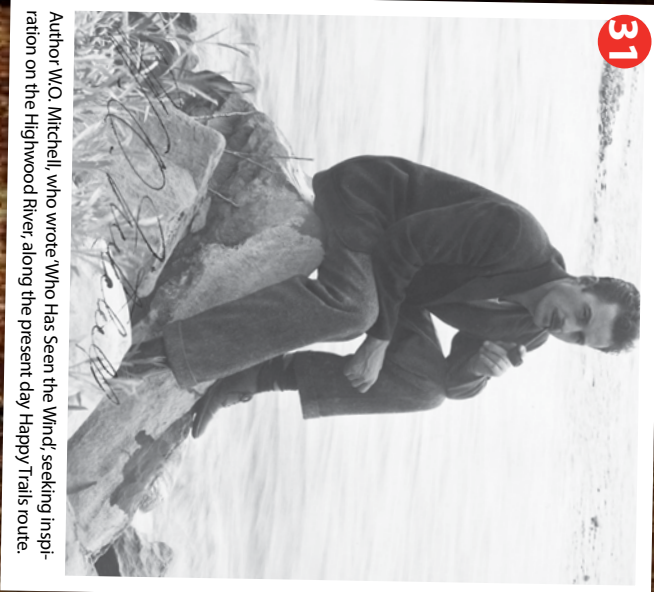

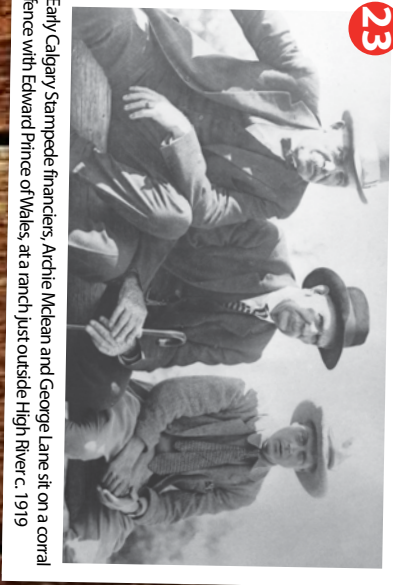
The Rodeo Grounds are host to the Little Britches Rodeo as well as Guy Weadick Days and North American Chuckwagon Races in May and June.

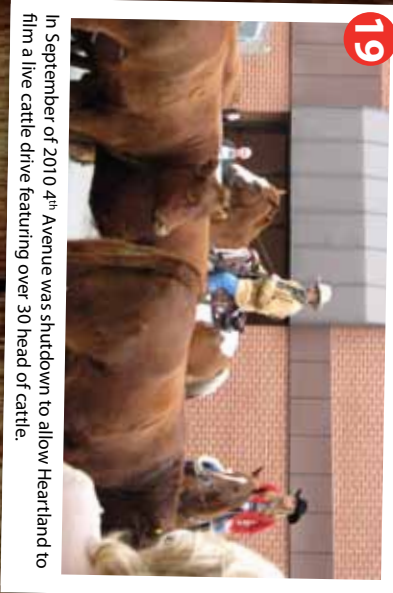
